TRAINING THE WORKFORCE

83% of employers surveyed by the Partnership on Employment and Accessible Technology (PEAT) see a moderate or significant increase the need for skills in accessibility. KSARN helps get those skills into the workforce and communicate them with non-credit badges issued through Credly.

- Most trainings take less than 30 minutes and all are self-paced and fully online
- Each class is targeted and skills-based
- A score of 85% or higher on the accompanying assessment leads to a Credly badge
